

## Regular Monthly Board Meeting Minutes, Town of Russell

October 11th, 2022 at 6:00 p.m.

- Notice of this meeting was posted 1 public place and on website.
  
- Chairman Robert Kressel called the Town of Russell board meeting to order on October 11, 2022 at 6:00 pm at the Russell Town Hall. All board members present, clerk, treasurer, and 5 town residents.
  
- Robert opened meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance
  
- **The minutes** from the September Town Board meeting were reviewed, approved with correction. Minutes approved with motion by Chairman Kressel, Second by Supervisor Sosnovske. Motion carried.
  
- **Treasure Report** – no outstanding business.
  
- **Vouchers**- Received and examined by board. Supervisor Heller made motion to pay vouchers; except Pomp's Tire Service. Supervisor Sosnovske Seconded. Motion carried.
  
- **Clerk** –
  - Robert has tried contacting Pomp's Tire service for billing correction. Unable to make contact.
  - November meeting changed to 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday, due to elections. Annual Budget meeting will be held at 6 p.m.; regular meeting to follow.
  
- **Road Report/Issues** –
  - Year-end, Jesse is trying to catch up and prepare for winter
  - Robert received call from crack-fillers, they were supposed to be here last Friday and finish up on Monday. Have not seen them.
  - Bill Bergman filled holes on Bradley with buckets of gravel.

- Bradley Street repairs will have to hold off until 2023 and see what LRIP money the town will receive.
  - Brian working on bridges. Working on town hall prep for new floor.
  - Email request from Town of Summit re: maintenance of County Line Rd for the past 3 years. It is not possible to fulfill their request. County Line is a low-maintenance road, no residents, no electricity and our priorities are not maintaining that road. Robert will call Mike Parizek to discuss. Better communication is needed between the townships.
  - Salt/Sand pad. Proceed as approved last month. Dave made motion to have Greg Lange do the excavating and footing work. Marty seconded. Motion carried. Robert did discuss with County Zoning. No permit is needed unless we go up.
  - Sander is on truck. Jesse would like approval for side swiper. No action taken.
- **Town Hall Maintenance –**
    - The town hall floor will be re-done the week of October 17<sup>th</sup> and no one will be allowed into the hall during that week. First Responders, FD and Sanitary have been notified.
  - **Zoning –**
    - Petition from VJM North Properties for modification to maintain minimum square footage for Section 33; TS 33N; R8E; Lot West ½ lot 6. Motion to sign by Robert. Second by Marty. Motion carried.
    - Ronald & Victoria Forster present with Petition for re-zoning to change from Forestry to Rural Lands-4. Motion to approve by Dave. Second by Marty.
