

Regular Monthly Board Meeting Minutes, Town of Russell

March 9, 2022 at 6:00 p.m.

- Notice of this meeting was posted 1 public place and on website.

- Chairman Robert Kressel called the Town of Russell board meeting to order on March 9, 2022 at 6:00 pm at the Russell Town Hall. All board members present, and seven town residents.

- **Pledge of Allegiance**

- **The minutes** from the February Town Board meeting were reviewed, approved with a motion by Supervisor Sosnovske, second by Supervisor Heller. Motion carried.

- **Treasure Report** – No outstanding business

- **Vouchers**- Received and examined by board. Robert explained the Fire Department request to transfer funds. As well as the Pomasl bill. Four new FD members, bill is for new gear and explained need to keep the gear up to date. Supervisor Heller made a motion to pay vouchers. Second by Supervisor Sosnovske. Motion carried.

- **Clerk** -will contact insurance agent about reviewing coverage prior to next board meeting at 5:30 pm

- **Road Report/Issues** –
 - Sand and more sand. Town needs own sand pile to save time and money. Discussion on getting a pad and buying it in bulk. Will look into for next year.
 - Robert discussed the Road Surface Management plan proposed by North Central Wisconsin Regional Planning Commission. Jesse felt their budget and proposal was pretty accurate and gives us a starting point. Bradley to County Rd J, still waiting to hear on the LRIP grant application.

- **New Town Garage**
 - Minutes of special meeting reviewed. Chairman Kressel stated issue was resolved and credit received on final bill received. Robert noted the lights are on before 6 am; Brian said he also noticed on late at night. Will need to be checked for sensitivity. Jesse stated the smoke detector is ultra-sensitive and goes off for no reason. Robert stated someone needs to look at owner's manual. 4 new keys received.

- **Sanitary District** –Chairman Kressel will check on cost for county to plow. Based on recent information received, a letter to be sent to Sanitary District stating the town’s charges for services (equipment, personnel, FD tanker). Supervisor Heller made a motion to send letter, Supervisor Sosnovske seconded. Motion carried.

- **Zoning** –
 - The town board is required to attend Board of Review Training and be certified every two years. At least one board member per year. Training is Friday, March 25th in Minocqua. Robert and Marty will attend. Dave will check his schedule. BOR date to be tabled until next meeting.

- **USDA Beaver control**

State Law per Dave. Robert explained to residents. Robert made motion to sign, Marty seconded. Motion carried. Signed. Clerk to return to USDA with \$700 fee.

- **Public Input**
 - Brian going to need 4x4s in spring to replace signs damaged over winter.
 - Marty would like one-lane road sign on Daxis Rd.
 - Brian stated he tried getting estimates for lawn mower and back-pack blower.
 - Robert noted that Spring election is April 5th. Both candidates for County Supervisor present if anyone had questions or concerns.
