 - Town of Harrison has been grading our side of Turtle Lake; our town needs to take care of their portion of R&H in timely manner.

- **Public Input**
 - Dave called New Coatings for guesstimate to replace town hall floor. Will get accurate estimate before next meeting.
 - Ronald asked what size culvert town approves for payment. He will purchase and bring receipt.

- Angela Cummins present. Extension has program to do survey for Economic Development, two towns need to go together. Not enough information available. Board will pass.
- Scott Taetsch is holding fire-arm training this Saturday. Wants town to be aware.
