

**Regular Monthly Board Meeting Minutes, Town of Russell**  
**January 10th, 2023 at 6:00 p.m.**

- Notice of this meeting was posted 1 public place and on website.
- Chairman Robert Kressel called the Town of Russell board meeting to order on January 10, 2023 at 6:00 pm at the Russell Town Hall. All board members present, clerk, treasurer, and 10 town residents.
- Chairman Kressel opened meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.
- **The minutes** from the December Town Board meeting were reviewed. Minutes approved with motion by Chairman Kressel, Second by Supervisor Heller. Motion carried.
- **Treasure Report** – no outstanding business.
- **Clerk** –
  - **Vouchers**- Received and examined by board. Supervisor Heller made motion to pay vouchers. Supervisor Sosnovske Seconded. Motion carried.
- **Road Report/Issues** –
  - Residents express concerns about intersections being icy. Requested more sand.
  - Inquiry to when Bradley will be re-done. Robert explained we were denied LRIP money for additional road repairs. Town aware and trying to get funding to repair.
  - Complaint from resident about snowmobiles on Town Hall Rd. Legally being used.
  - Chairman Kressel advised we were approved for \$112,340.06 for Road Money in 2023
- **Elections** –
  - Four candidates for town supervisor. Chairman Kressel drew names for order on April ballot.
- **Town Garage** –
  - Overhead doors were adjusted. Will continue to monitor
  - Back-up heating is working
  - Robert contacted Cliff from KSW regarding concerns
- **Zoning** –
  - Have received nothing from County. Robert will contact County Zoning office to follow up.
  - Insurance company is handling.
- **Fuel** –
  - Marty asked about diesel bills for last year. River Country had us around 2,300 gallons. Asked Jesse if that sounded accurate. He felt it was. We are out of contract. Current contract price is \$3.39 per gallon. \$3.43 off truck. \$3.29 pre-pay/lock-in. 2022 we contracted for 1,000 gallons. Given use of 2022, Robert made a motion to contract with River Country for 2,500 gallons. Second by Marty. Motion carried. Marty will contact them for pricing and contract.
- **Public Comment** –
  - Rabies Clinic scheduled for 3/16/2023. Haven't had for two years. New vet willing and able to come to Fire Barn.
  - Concern of round bale blocking mailbox on 1<sup>st</sup> Ave.
