- Notice of this meeting was posted in 1 public place and on website.
- Chairman Kressel called the meeting to order at 6:01 p.m. Present- Robert, Lori, Marty, Amy, Sue, and two town residents.
- Chairman Kressel opened meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

 - Liquor License application for Wagner Shell Gleason, LLC. Advertised in Foto News; presented to board. Motion to approve Liquor and Nicotine licenses by Chairman Kressel. Second, by Supervisor Studinski. Motion carried.
- **Roads** –
 - Chip sealing on Bradley and north Town Hall completed today. They suggest to put another layer on next year to extend the life of the road of 10 years. Lori will get numbers and present at next month's meeting and preparation of budget.
 - Robert talked to Brian Hanson from Harrison re: sharing cost of gravel on R&H. Marty made a motion to go with Harrison on half for \$4,000 cost to town. Second by Robert. Motion carried. Robert will let Chairman Hanson know.
 - Supervisor Studinski stated brushing needs to be done and continued grading so the roads are in better shape for spring.
 - Emergency Road Service for patrol truck discussion. Agreed we should still carry this for \$450. Robert made a motion to renew coverage. Lori second. Carried.
- **Cemetery-**
 - Robert left message for Ison regarding tree removal. He will try again with updated numbers that Marty gave him.
- **Parks** –
 - Trees were removed by volunteers and clean-up to continue.
 - SGS was contracted to do park excavation; work to begin end of September.
- **Public Comment-**
 - Chief Tim Steinfest updated board on recent purchase of a Lucas from auction.
